



April 10, 2014

Brother Dennis Price said the Prayer.

1. Mayor Eric Selby called the meeting to order.
2. **David Blakey made the motion to accept the March 13 minutes. Lisa Mann seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
3. **Eddie Thomas made the motion to pay the bills. Joshua Robertson seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
4. Timmy Hudson asked regarding the road in front of Subway; can anything be done because the road stays wet. Could there possibly be a spring or a water leak? Mayor Selby stated he would contact Terry Russell to see if a potential leak is there. David Blakey said Michael Selby had stated that road would get new asphalt and didn't seem to think there was a leak.
5. David Blakey came to the Downtown Revitalization meeting on Tuesday Night. Festival has a name change---Festival at the Springs---September 5 and 6

Mayor Eric Selby read Municipal Order No. 2014-01 Transferring of funds from the Land Acquisition Account to the Water and Sewer Account. **Timmy Hudson made the motion to accept Municipal Order No. 2014-01 Transferring of funds from the Land Acquisition to the Water and Sewer Account. David Blakey seconded the motion. Roll call vote with Mr. Blakey-yes; Ms. Mann-yes; Mr. Barnes-yes; Mr. Thomas-yes; Mr. Robertson-yes; Mr. Hudson-yes. Motion carried 6-0.**
7. The Council heard the 1st reading of Ordinance No. 2014-02.
8. Mayor Selby informed the Council that the final payment of \$20,000 had been paid to South Ky. RECC for the Senior Citizens Building. With this payment the building is paid in full.
9. **David Blakey made the motion to adjourn. Lisa Mann seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
