The Russell Springs City Council held their regular monthly meeting this date at City Hall at 6:00 p.m. In attendance were Ramie Hutchison, Jim Lien, Harold Schackow, Joe Irvin, Joshua Robertson, Eddie Thomas, David Blakey, Lisa Mann, Matthew DeHart, Eric Selby and Wendy Burton. Absent were Timmy Hudson and Ricky Barnes.

1. Mayor Eric Selby called the meeting to order.
2. **Eddie Thomas made the motion to accept the June 12 minutes. Lisa Mann seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.**
3. **David Blakey made the motion to pay the bills. Eddie Thomas seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.**
4. Mr. Harold Schackow came before the Council regarding easements/contracts that were done in September 1990 in the amount of approximately \$3,000. After Mr. Schackow had talked to City Attorney DeHart, he was told contracts/easements were outside the statute of limitations. Mayor Selby suggested having City Attorney DeHart investigate each easement for validity. **David Blakey made the motion for City Attorney Matthew DeHart to look into easements for Harold Schackow's water lines. Eddie Thomas seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.** Mr. Schackow will take papers to City Attorney's office on Friday to have copies made.
5. Mayor Selby updated the Council on the Downtown Revitalization: In the process of placing 6-8 Historic Signs; Festival at the Springs- September 5&6; Borrowed Blue Band with Matt Cooper will be here; Benchmark-Foster Children Organization will have volunteers for the festival and haunted woods and Meet the candidates. New member-Lynn Wilson- owner of Main St. Mini Mall in the old Dollar Store building.
6. Mayor Selby also informed the Council for FY 13-14 KLC's insurance was \$180097.00 And for FY 14-15 is \$169747.88, a savings of \$10349.12. This being a result of no accidents, safety of employees, etc.
7. **David Blakey made the motion to adjourn. Joshua Robertson seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.**
