



November 12, 2015

1. Mayor Eric Selby called the meeting to order.
2. **Eddie Thomas made the motion to accept the October 8 minutes. Sherry Daniel seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
3. **Ricky Barnes made the motion to pay the bills. Timmy Hudson seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
4. Trunk or Treat went very well. Weather cooperated; Thank you to the Russell Springs Christian Church, Liberty Baptist Church and Russell Springs Methodist Church for their partnerships.
5. Drew Ulmer with Baldwin CPA's presented the FY 6/30/15 audit. Baldwin CPA's have completed the City of Russell Springs audit for several years; Good News- NO significant issues; **CLEAN AUDIT OPINION**; no non-compliance issues. Drew stated they enjoyed working with the City. **Tommy Holt made the motion to accept the FY 6/30/15 audit. Sherry Daniel seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
6. Mayor Selby stated the Christmas Parade will be November 28 with the theme being "True Meaning of Christmas". Any help would be appreciated.
7. December 3 and December 10 will be the Downtown Revitalization's Open House on Main Street with Carriage Rides (weather permitting) and Santa.
