- 1. Mayor Eric Selby called the meeting to order.
- 2. Eddie Thomas made the motion to accept the February 12<sup>th</sup> and February 23<sup>rd</sup> minutes. Ricky Barnes seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
- Eddie Thomas made the motion to pay the bills. Sherry Daniel seconded the motion.

- 4. Jeramy Coffey reported on the Land & Water Playground Equipment Grant. Has everything ready to submit excluding what type of unit and how much going to spend. It is a 50/50 grant. In-kind labor does count. Also need to decide on the filler material that goes around playground equipment. Can be sand, mulch or rubberized mulch. - 6. Mayor Selby reported he will be meeting with Brandon Selby this weekend, driving city roads and making list of road repairs needing to be fixed from the bad weather. Blacktop is cheaper this year. Less than \$80 a ton, last year was in the \$90's.
