


January 14, 2016

PRAYER WAS SAID BY EDDIE THOMAS.

1. Mayor Eric Selby called the meeting to order.
2. **Eddie Thomas made the motion to accept the December 10 minutes and December 22 minutes. Tommy Holt seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
3. **Ricky Barnes made the motion to pay the bills. David Blakey seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
4. Mayor Selby informed the Council new Playground equipment will be delivered around the first of March.
5. Mayor Selby along with the City Council recognized and commended **Erik Logan Crittenden** for receiving Eagle Scout. Erik stated he had worked his way up throughout the ten (10) year period he has been involved with Troop 241. This Troop is retiring due to one leader having colon cancer and one leader having worked with the chapter for 24 years. Other chapters are located in Somerset, Bowling Green and Liberty.
6. Mayor Selby stated one appointment to the Lake Cumberland Natural Gas Authority needed to be taken care of. City of Russell Springs has three members as does the City of Jamestown. **Sherry Daniel made the motion to reappoint H.M. Bottom to Lake Cumberland Natural Gas Board for another 3 year term.
