


November 11, 2010

The Russell Springs City Council held their regular monthly meeting this date at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall. 1. Mayor Hollis DeHart called the meeting to order.
2. **Timmy Hudson made the motion to accept the minutes of 9/28 and 10/14. David Blakey seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
3. **Ray Barrett made the motion to pay the bills. Lisa Mann seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
4. The Council heard the 2nd reading of Model Procurement Ordinance 2010-08. Mayor DeHart stated this permits the City to purchase everyday supplies without getting a quote on purchases less than \$3,000, with every effort being made to get the lowest and best price. **David Blakey made the motion to accept Model Procurement Ordinance 2010-08. Eric Selby seconded the motion. Roll Call vote with Timmy Hudson-aye, David Blakey-aye, Eric Selby-aye, Ray Barrett-aye, Lisa Mann-aye, Ricky Barnes-aye. Motion carried 6-0.**
5. Mayor DeHart discussed rental of the old Police Department building for \$500 per month for governmental offices. **Timmy Hudson made the motion to rent the old Police Department building. Ray Barrett seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
6. Christmas Dinner will be December 4 at 6:00 p.m. at the Fire Department building. Meat and dressing will be provided. Everyone is asked to bring a dish.
7. Today is Veterans Day. Mayor DeHart stated he was fortunate not having to fight. Millions of men and women lost their lives and we owe them Thanks, Respect and Admiration. I was watching a show on Patton, unbelievable the amount of men he lost and how many medals were awarded-men with uncommon valor. Mayor DeHart stated his grandfather fought in the Civil War, his father fought in WW I and he was in the Navy. Not only do the soldiers pay the price, but also the families. When you say your prayers, ask the Lord for their safeness. David Blakey stated the Medal of Honor was bestowed on a gentleman from Greensburg.
8. Ray Barrett stated he had been approached by parents stating this year's Trunk or Treat was a mess; more commercial than for the children.
