- 1. Mayor Brian Walters called the meeting to order.
- 2. Mayor Walters asked regarding item # 4 a business license for that business; also check was sent.
- 3. Mayor Walters made the motion to accept the minutes of February 9 as written. Eric Selby seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- 4. - 6. Discussion regarding overtime worked on holidays in the Park, Streets, Water and Police Departments. Mayor Walters asked that City Clerk be given that authority to contact Paul Combs to draw up a new policy on overtime.
- 7. Mayor Walters made the motion to enter executive session according to KRS 61.810 (1) (c) possible litigation and KRS 61.810 (1) (f) personnel at 5:15 p.m. Eric Selby seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- 8. The Commission reconvened at 5:45 in open session with no action taken.

10. Mayor Walters made the motion to adjourn. Joe Branscum seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
