The Russell Springs City Council held their regular monthly meeting this date at City Hall at 6:00 p.m. In attendance were Janice Blair, Derek Aaron, Jeanne Hudson, Claradon Wilson, David Harris, Charles Gossett, Bobby Brown, Amy Mischler, Richard Roy, Ramie Hutchison, Joe Irvin, Ray Barrett, Lisa Mann, Ricky Barnes, Timmy Hudson, David Blakey, Eric Selby, Don Byrom, Hollis DeHart and Wendy Burton.

1. Mayor Hollis DeHart called the meeting to order.
2. **David Blakey made the motion to accept the June 5 minutes as written. Timmy Hudson seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
3. David Blakey asked regarding a check to Dennis Franklin for vehicle painting. Mayor DeHart stated a street behind the old dollar store building had caused damage to the Franklin vehicle. **Ray Barrett made the motion to pay the bills. Eric Selby seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
4. The Council heard the 2nd reading of the Amended Budget Ordinance 2009-05 for Fiscal year 07/01/08 through 06/30/09. **Timmy Hudson made the motion to accept the Amended Budget Ordinance 2009-05. Lisa Mann seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
5. Mayor DeHart informed the Council that upon the advice of the Kentucky League of Cities a Safety Director was hired a year ago. As a result of this, the City of Russell Springs will save \$37,000 in insurance premiums for 2009-2010. Also health insurance for employees only increased 2% for 2009-2010.
6. Charles Gossett and David Harris presented plaques of appreciation to the City of Russell Springs, The Russell Springs Police Department and Downtown Revitalization for their involvement of the car show.
7. The Council heard the 1st reading of Ordinance 2009-06 Updating the Compensation Plan.
8. Resolution 2009-06 Municipal Road Aid for \$26,466. was introduced to the Council. **Lisa Mann made the motion to accept Resolution 2009-06 Municipal Road Aid for \$26,466. David Blakey seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
9. **Timmy Hudson made the motion to adjourn. Ray Barrett seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
