The Russell Springs City Commission held a special called meeting this date at 2:00 p.m. In attendance were Derek Aaron, Joe Irvin, Ray Barrett, Wayne Gaskins, Timmy Hudson, Richard Wooldridge, Don Byrom, Hollis DeHart and Wendy Burton.

- 1. Mayor Hollis DeHart called the meeting to order.
- 2. Ray Barrett asked regarding item #2 on June 14 minutes. Mayor DeHart informed the Commission that part-time employees have to be given the opportunity for health insurance. If the employees are laid off in the fall, then the employees would go on COBRA. Wayne Gaskins stated why not make the part-time employees full time employees then if laid off they could draw unemployment? Mayor DeHart made the motion to accept the minutes of June 14. - 3. Motion carried 5-0.
- 4. The Commission heard the 2nd reading of Amended Budget Ordinance 2007-23 for FY 2006-2007. Wayne Gaskins made the motion to accept the Amended Budget Ordinance 2007-23 for FY 2006-2007. Richard Wooldridge seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- 5. Richard Wooldridge made the motion to accept bids on the Julia Collins building on Main Street. Wayne Gaskins seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- 6. Mayor DeHart made the motion to accept the agreement with K-Mart on 2002 unpaid taxes. Wayne Gaskins seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
- 7. Wayne Gaskins made the motion to pay all remaining legitimate bills through June 30, 2007. Mayor DeHart seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

8. Mayor DeHart made the motion to adjourn. Richard Wooldridge seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
