

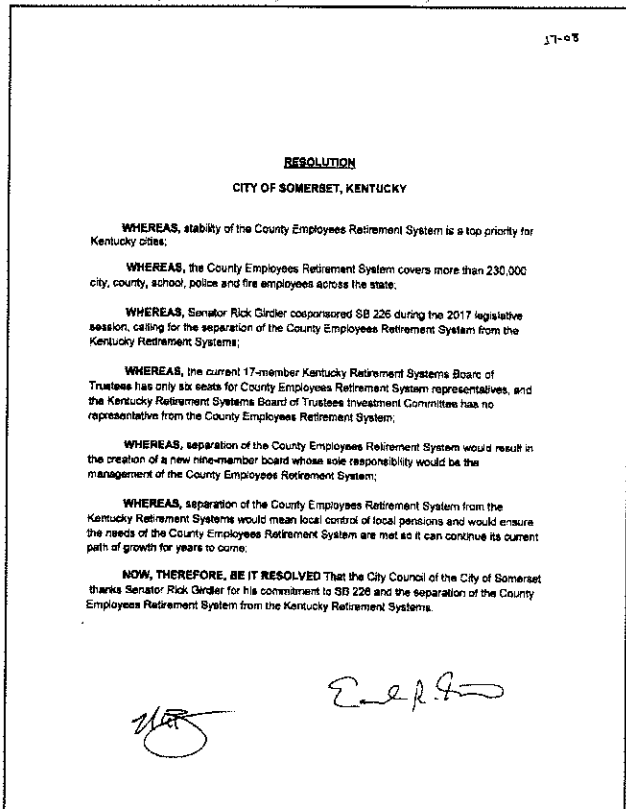
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 26, 2017

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular meeting on Monday June 26, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Council Members; Mike New, Donna Hunley, John Minton, Jim Mitchell, John Adams, Amanda Bullock, Tom Eastham, Brian Dalton, Jerry Wheeldon Jimmy Eastham and Jerry Girdler and Mayor Eddie Girdler, and City Clerk Nick Bradley. Mr. Wheeldon moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on June 12, 2017 along with reports as mailed. Mr. New seconded the motion. ORDINANCE NUMBER 17-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2017 ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, AN ANNUAL BUDGET HAS BEEN ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY; AND

WHEREAS, THE COMMON COUNCIL HAS RECEIVED PROPOSED BUDGET CHANGES AND HAS MADE NECESSARY MODIFICATIONS;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. THAT THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2017 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:



ORDINANCE NO. 17-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 00-18, KNOWN AS THE CITY'S ZONING ORDINANCE, AND ALTERING THE ZONING MAP TO REFLECT SAID AMENDMENT, BASED ON FINDINGS OF FACT MADE BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD, AND BASED ON SAID BOARD'S RECOMMENDATION OF A ZONE CHANGE;


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:


This Ordinance No. 00-18, known as the Zoning Ordinance, Somerset, Kentucky, is hereby amended by altering the Zoning Map in the following manner:

- By changing a boundary of land presently zoned R2 to R3, said property being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein in full by reference, specifically with an address of 221 Langdon Street, Somerset, KY, and a PVA Parcel # of 061-4-2-04.
- The City Clerk of the City of Somerset, Kentucky is hereby authorized to alter the Zoning Map to reflect said change.
- This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after adoption and publication according to law.

Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the above Ordinance No. 17-13: Zone Change to R-3 of 221 Langdon St. Mr. Wheeldon seconded the motion. First reading was given the following Ordinance No. 17-14:

ORDINANCE NO. 17-14

AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, CREATING A CIVIL FINGERPRINTING IMPRESSION SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING AN INITIAL FEE FOR SAID CIVIL FINGERPRINTING SERVICES APPLICABLE IF SAID IMPRESSIONS ARE TO BE USED FOR PROFESSIONAL, TRADE, OR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES, OR IF SAID IMPRESSIONS ARE TO BE USED FOR PERSONAL USE.

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset wishes to provide civil fingerprinting, impression services to the public, but due to the costs involved in providing said services, herein states its desire to charge a reasonable fee for said service as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that no applicable KRS prohibits the City from providing said service, and that applicable KRS allows the City to assess a fee for providing such a service so long as the fee is not in excess of the reasonable costs associated with providing said service;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Somerset that a Civil Fingerprinting Impression Service may hereafter be provided by the Somerset Police Department for a fee as set forth herein:

(A) For the purpose of establishing an initial fee structure for the services described above, the City of Somerset does hereby authorize the City, by and through the Somerset Police Department, to charge a *minimum* fee of \$5.00 (Five Dollars and 00/100) per person, per set (2 cards) of fingerprint impressions when said service is requested by a person for professional, trade, or commercial purposes, or if said service is requested by a person for personal use. Should the costs of processing fingerprinting impression requests rise above the fee amount set forth in this section, the City of Somerset may adjust the fee through administrative action of the City's executive authority as permitted by KRS Chapter 83A, Chapter 91A, and all other applicable law. Any fee charged for said service, including the initial charge set forth herein, and any adjustments which may be made in the future by the executive authority to account for an increase in costs for providing said services, will not generate revenues or profits in excess of the reasonable costs associated with providing said service to the public.

(B) If any part of this Ordinance is deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.


(C) Any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance, or any policies in conflict with the ones enacted herein are repealed in so far as the same are in conflict herewith.

(D) This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval and publication according to law. The implementation date for this Ordinance shall be August 1, 2017.
