



September 28, 2010

The Russell Springs City Council held a special called meeting on this date at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall. In attendance were Louis & Tonya Stargel, John Thompson, Kim Graham, Joe Irvin, Ray Barrett, Lisa Mann, Ricky Barnes, Eric Selby, David Blakey, Athena Cooper, Hollis DeHart and Wendy Burton. Timmy Hudson arriving after first motion.

1. Mayor Hollis DeHart called the meeting to order.
2. **Lisa Mann made the motion to accept the minutes of September 21. David Blakey seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.**
3. Discussion regarding the donation of \$2,000.00 per month to the Ambulance/911 Services. City of Jamestown has agreed to donate \$2,000 per month contingent upon the Ambulance Board contributing \$2,000 per month. Should the City of Russell Springs agree and the Ambulance/911 agree then the remaining financial assistance would come from the Russell County Fiscal Court after CMRS money, collected taxes, ambulance run charges and any other monies that are paid to 911 or the ambulance service. This situation will have to be revisited again and again within the next year. A new inter-local agreement will have to be put in place and a ~~minimum~~ maximum of \$2,000 from each entity will have to be contributed, with the Russell County Fiscal Court contributing the remainder of money **David Blakey made the motion to donate \$2,000 per month to ambulance/911. Eric Selby seconded the motion. Timmy Hudson -nay, Ray Barrett-nay, with the remaining voting aye. Motion carried 4-2.** Mayor DeHart informed the Council that the Lake Cumberland Natural Gas Board had met and dividend money had been discussed. Each entity-City of Jamestown, City of Russell Springs and Russell County Fiscal Court will receive \$25,000 from the Natural Gas. This will be enough to pay the first year's assistance to the ambulance/911 for the City of Russell Springs.
4. **Ray Barrett made the motion to adjourn. Timmy Hudson seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.**
