## DELIVERY AND SELLING ORDINANCE

The Board of Trusteem of the Town of Russell Springs, Kentucky, do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to deliver or sell in the corporate limits of the town of Russell Springs, Kentucky, from truck, wagon, or any other vehicle, any merchandise, groceries, meats, vegetables, or any other commodity to the merchants, or any other individual of the said town without first paying to the said town a license of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per annum.

SECTION TWO. Any person, firm, or corporation vidlating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and upon conviction in the police court of the town of Russell Springs, Kentucky, any person, firm, or corporation so offending shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00), nor more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each offense.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, approval and publication as required by law, and all ordinances, resolutions, orders, or parts thereof in conflict herewith to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed.
