ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND PRESCRIBING THE MANNER IN WHICH ALL VEHICLES SHALL BE LEFT OR PARKED ON MAINSTREET OF THE TOWN OF RUSSELL SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, BETWEEN THE PLACES OR POINTS WHERE JAMESTOWN AND WILSON STREETS OF SAID TOWN, RESPECTIVELY, INTERSECT SAID MAIN STREET, MAKING AND DECLARING ANY BREACH OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE TO BE A MISDEMEANOR, AND PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Russell Springs, Kentucky, do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE. All vehicles, whether motor driven or drawn by animals, that are hereafter left, placed, or parked on Main Street of Russell Springs, Kentucky, between the places or points where Jamestown and Wilson Streets of said Town enter or intersect said Main Street, respectively, shall be placed, left or parked in the following manner, to-wit:

I. All motor driven vehicles shall be placed at an angle of forty-five (45) degrees as near as may be to the line of the sidewalks running along said Main Street, unless a different angle is indicated by marking on said sidewalks, in which case such vehicles shall be placed at the angle indicated, and in all cases the right front wheel of such said vehicle shall be brought to rest within not less than ______ inches of such sidewalks.

SECTION TWO. All vehicles shall be considered left, placed or parked within the meaning of the provisions of this

ordinance when the movement of same has been halted for a space of ______ consecutive minutes.

SECTION THREE. Any breach of the provisions of this ordinance shall and is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, and any person, firm or corporation so offending shall, on conviction in the Police Court of the Town of Russell Springs, Kentucky, be punished by a fine of not less \$ 500 and not more than \$ 19.00 for each offense.

SECTION FOUR. This ordinance shall be and become in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, approval and publication as required by law, and all ordinances, resolutions, orders, or parts of same, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
