

RUSSELL SPRINGS CITY COUNCIL MEETING
SPECIAL CALLED REGULAR MEETING
FRIDAY, AUGUST 18, 2023
7:30 A.M.

The Russell Springs City Council held a special called meeting on Friday, August 18, 2023, at 7:30 a.m., in the Council Room at Russell Springs City Hall. Those in attendance were Mayor Eddie Thomas, Council Members: Ricky Barnes, David Blakey, Timmy Hudson, Sherry Daniel, Cody Wilson, and Lisa Mann, Interim Police Chief Bryan Shepard, Zoning Administrator Tommy Holt, Director of Facilities Brian Stephens, and City Clerk Christopher Ramsey:

WELCOME: Mayor Thomas convened the meeting and greeted everyone, emphasizing that only matters outlined in the agenda would be open for discussion.

ROLL CALL: City Clerk Christopher Ramsey performed the roll call. Council Members Present: Mr. Barnes, Mr. Hudson, Mr. Wilson, Ms. Daniel, Mr. Blakey, and Ms. Mann.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 2023-07: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER AND SEWER TAP COSTS AND OTHER RELATED FEES (SPONSORED BY COUNCILWOMAN BLAKEY): Clerk Ramsey provided the second reading of Ordinance 2023-07. **Councilwoman Mann made a motion to accept Municipal Order 2023-07 as presented with Councilwoman Daniel seconding. Motion Carried. The vote was unanimous.**

INTERLOCAL ROAD AGREEMENT WITH RUSSELL COUNTY FISCAL COURT – DISTRICT 4: Mayor Thomas stated that he would like to go ahead and enter into an agreement with the Russell County Fiscal Court and Magistrate Stevie Richardson. Mayor Thomas said this agreement is the same as the previously adopted agreement with District Five. **Councilman Wilson made a motion to accept the Interlocal Road Agreement with the Russell County Fiscal Court for District 4 with Councilman Hudson seconding. Motion Carried. The vote was unanimous.**

2023-2024 INTERLOCAL E-911 AGREEMENT: Clerk Ramsey presented the 911 agreement and noted that there were zero changes from the previous year's agreement. The current agreement is for thirty-five thousand dollars. Mayor Thomas stated that he did not want to give the County that amount and recommended that the city only give twenty-five thousand. **Councilwoman Mann made a motion to accept the agreement at thirty-five thousand with Councilwoman Daniel seconding. Roll Call: Yes: Mann, Daniel, Blakey. No: Barnes, Hudson, Wilson. Tie Vote: Mayor Thomas voted no to defeat the motion.**

After the motion was defeated, Councilman Wilson made a motion to accept the agreement at twenty-five thousand with Councilman Hudson seconding. Roll Call: Yes: Barnes, Hudson, Wilson. No: Mann, Daniel, Blakey. Tie Vote: Mayor Thomas voted yes to accept the motion.


ADJOURNMENT: Councilman Barnes made a motion to adjourn the meeting with Councilman Holt seconding. All was in favor.
